___Crayons: one box of no more than 24. Crayola brand works best

___Some students also like markers or highlighters

___Pencils: 10 to share with the class - I will pass them out as needed

___Eraser

___Scissors: Blunt-tipped

___Glue sticks: three (no liquid glue needed)

___Pocket Folders - Two sturdy, solid colors only

___Headphones in a Ziploc bag with both headphones and bag labeled with name

___Box for Supplies: Sturdy, plastic, "cigar box" type fits best in the desk

___One Primary ruled Mead Composition Books: This is a hard cover book with sewn-in pages. The Primary ones have the dotted line for printing. I have seen them at Staples or Office Max.

___One-half-inch 3 ring notebook binder (the thinnest size binder)

___Two boxes of Tissues (to share with the class)

___Outdoor Shoes: Due to the playground mud, inexpensive play shoes are needed for outdoor play. The shoes will be kept in your child's cubby. Slip-ons or Velcro work the best, especially if you child is unable to tie yet.

___Snack: A daily nutritious snack and juice box

___If two or three parents would like to send in a large bottle of hand sanitizer that will get us started.
