

Second Grade Summer Reading List

Second graders should be reading, or be read to, several times a week. I would suggest that they read with you most of the time since beginning readers are not usually independent readers.

Please work hard to help your child select books that are appropriate for his/her reading level. For many child that will be the “easy reader” section of the public library. We do units on Nate the Great, by Sharmat, easy reader historical fiction by Benchley, the Cul-De-Sac Kids, and Cam Jensen by Adler. So, you may want to avoid those books so that they are fresh when we read them at school.

Here are some types of literature that summer reading must include:

1. One animal story
2. One adventure or mystery story
3. Two Bible stories one Old Testament and one New Testament. You might want to use a children’s Bible story book
4. One non- fiction story
5. One poem

Please send in a list including the title and author (or scripture reference for #3) of each of the above books.
